December 22, 2023	Approved pre-proposals notified to submit full proposal

January 2024	Research Committee reviews full proposals and selects those to recommend for funding to MN Wheat Council Board ( <i>date to be determined</i> )
Jan/Feb 2024	MN Wheat Council acts on committee recommendations at their board meeting ( <i>date to be determined</i> )
Jan/Feb, 2024	PI's and researchers notified of MN Wheat Council funding decisions. Begin contracting process between MN Wheat and individual institution

*Note: Pre-proposals are different from a full proposal, in that the pre-proposal does not require being processed through university/organization accounting systems. If a full proposal is requested of the project after a presentation has been made to the Research Committee, then the full proposal must go through your organization's normal proposal submission process.*
