Crop Year 2023 Wheat Request for Research Pre-Proposal

Due by 12:00 p.m. Friday, November 18th, 2022

Dear Researchers,

The Minnesota Wheat Research and Promotion Council will once again accept research proposals that aim to improve the productivity of wheat production in Minnesota and the region by increasing yields, lowering input costs, or increasing the value of wheat we produce. Attached is a list of research areas the Committee would be interested in funding.

The deadline to submit a pre-proposal is 12:00 p.m. on Friday, November 19, 2022.

This year, the Minnesota Wheat Research and Promotion Council (MWRPC) will have up to approximately ~\$250,000 to fund proposal requests for the FY 2023 funding cycle. Projects may be funded for up to three years, beginning January 1st and ending December 31st of the calendar year.

Each PI will be given 10-15 minutes to present their pre-proposal virtually or in-person to the research committee on the afternoon of December 7th, 2022, in Grand Forks at MN Wheat's Prairie Grains Conference.

If funded, one half of the awarded research funds will be deposited by July 2021, and the second half will be deposited upon the submission of the annual research report and a report of expenditures in November. The annual research report will be due to mcarlson@mnheat.com AND Beth@agmgmtsolutions.com by 12:00pm on November 15th, and will be published in MN Wheat's annual Wheat Research Review and reporting booklet that will be disseminated to area farmers and industry workers by MN Wheat and University of MN Extension during winter educational meetings.

We encourage coordination between small plot research and large scale on-farm research wherever coordination may enhance or accelerate the research and education outcomes.

If you would like additional guidance or grower feedback, we can arrange for a few of our growers to meet with you prior to the pre-proposal deadline to discuss and provide their feedback on your pre-proposal ideas. The outcome of this could be a more refined pre-proposal through grower input.
